Snow and Critical Incidents.

Snow

In the event of snow falling during the night, we will endeavour to put a notice on our school website informing parents if we are able to open or if there is a change to the opening and closing times of our school for that day. We try very hard to keep the school open and to date have always managed, even if it means we have had to close a little earlier than usual. Please also listen to local radio for school closures.

Critical Incidents

A critical incident is a serious emergency that can mean the school closing e.g. fire, gas leak. Should an incident of this nature occur, we have a policy and procedure in place that includes putting up to date information on our school website.

At the start of each academic year a letter is sent out to parents informing them of a name and phone number that they can contact for a critical incident. The procedure would be that school will inform each of the 9 contacts of what is happening and the organisation for parents. In this way, school phone lines are kept open for school to be in contact with emergency services.
