Number of children on roll	330	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have admitted 60 children into Reception classes this year (called our PAN). Currently our PAN for September 2019 is 60. We are extending to accommodate 420 from September 2019, once our building works are completed in August 2019. Previously our PAN has been 45 however in some years groups, Admissions have asked us to go over 'PAN' and so some year groups have more than 45+ .
Number / % of children who have Free School Meals	29 / 9.67%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The number of children taking FSM has increased. The school gain funding of £1,900 per pupil. Since September 2014 there is Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM). Every child up to the age of 7 years old is entitled to a free school meal. Governors continue to work hard to inform parents about considering if they are eligible to claim FSM

Number of Looked After Children	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We currently have 1 child in school who are LAC. Mrs Kendall– Headteacher - is the named person for Looked After Children
Number / % of children where English is an additional language	53 / 16.06%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This number has increased over the years significantly but is now stable. Some children arrive with very little or no English. We have developed a package in some of the 18 languages spoken by our children that is for the parent and child when they come to The Bellbird. We have purchased new IT software resources to help children learn
Number / % of children who are on the Special Educational Needs register	18 / 5.45 %	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have 9 children in our school for whom we receive additional funding to meet their needs. These children have allocated teaching assistant hours, some paid for by the Local Authority and some paid for by school.

Tracking all children's progress		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupil Progress Meetings are held every 8 weeks. Class teachers prepare for these meetings by looking at the progress of every single child in their class. • At the pupil progress meetings, those children who are not making expected progress are discussed and plans put in place to support them further eg with intervention programmes • The progress of groups of children are also tracked – children with FSM / SEN / English as an additional language/ children who are more able.
