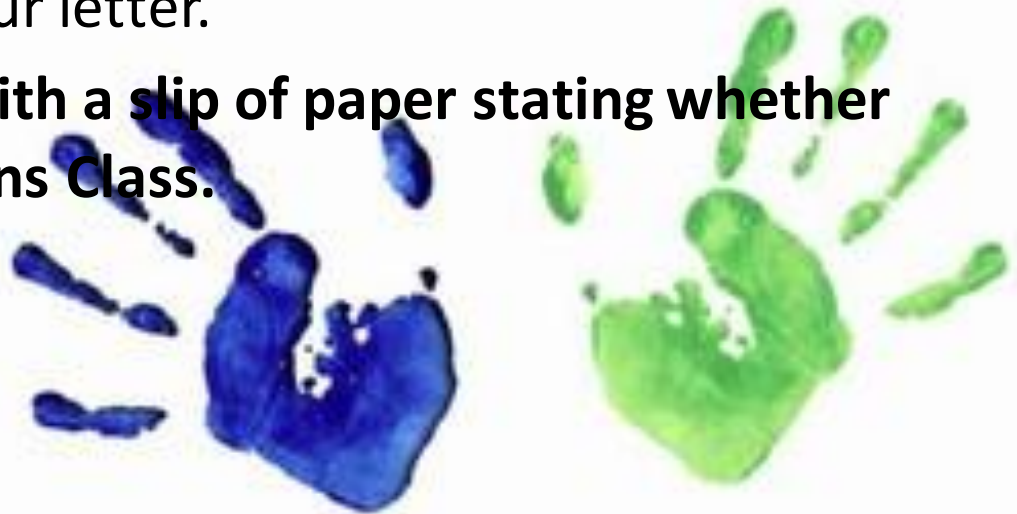
First Two Weeks

Starting School 2020

- Please bring your child to school and line up in the marked bays to drop off and collect your child.
- If you think your child is likely to have a toileting accident please bring spare underwear and clothes in a plastic bag. We can keep these on your child's peg.
- Due to Covid 19 restrictions we may telephone you for small discussions that would normally have been a quick chat at the end of the day.

Hygiene Routines

What do we need to bring to school?

- Named water bottle.
- Monday is P.E. Day – P.E. is in the hall. Please send your child to School in their P.E. kit. They will wear this all day.
- Book bag for letters to be sent home.
- Up to date asthma inhaler and care plan if needed.
- Coat (We have outside learning every day.)
- Reading book and reading record once distributed (around October half term). This needs to come into school every day and the TAs will look at your child's individual record on a specific day.

What can you do to help?

- Read together **every day** and **ask questions** about the story.
- Encourage your children to change independently.
- Use number problems in everyday life. E.g. recognising numbers in the environment, telling the time and counting on the way to school.
- Praise the process rather than the outcome.
- Let us know what your child can do at home using Tapestry and sending in WOW card.
- Encourage your child to talk to you about their day and speak to us about any concerns.
