

Self- isolation support for children in Year 2: Skylarks and Goldfinches

These tasks are not for children who are unwell (covid-19 or any other illness), who should obviously be resting until they are well enough to return to school.

This page contains advice on home learning, in the event of household self-isolation, due to COVID-19. The Bellbird Primary School will ensure learning can continue for year 2 pupils remotely. Each year group's learning choices reflects what they are currently covering in school, whilst also allowing for some choice to help you to engage and keep your child motivated to learn at home.

Main daily/weekly tasks:

- **White Rose Maths**-links directly to maths objectives being taught in class
Every lesson comes with a short video showing you clearly and simply how to help your child complete the activity successfully.
