Daily / Weekly

- **Reading:** read **with** your child for a minimum of 15 minutes each day –team points for children who read every day at home – don't forget the weekend!
- **Number:** Mathematics homework will be set every other week. Practice the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.
- **Spelling:** Will be set every Friday and tested the following Friday.
- Purple Mash: Complete the 2Dos linked to phonics, spelling and Monster Multiplication.
- **Pirate Costume:** For our pirate day at the end of the summer term, each child will need a pirate costume. **No weapons please!**
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Topic related activities

We would like you to complete 3 of these (but you can do more!).

Make a traditional dish from a country within The United Kingdom (England, Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland). Bring in photos of the dish and be prepared to explain how you made it e.g. Eccles cakes, soda bread, Welsh cakes.

Choose an animal that is **not** native to the UK and create a mini fact-file or a piece of artwork linked to the selected creature.

Choose a short poem by a poet who lives in the UK. Learn the poem off by heart and be prepared to recite it to a small group or the rest of the class. You could add appropriate sound effects, using the voice or body percussion (e.g. Robert Louis Stevenson- 'From A Railway Carriage').

Perform a traditional song from an area of the UK e.g. a traditional English folk song.

Find out about some real life pirates. Record interesting facts using a leaflet or a poster.

Create a recipe that we could use in our year 2 mud kitchen. Follow your recipe and make your dish. Take some photos of your creation.

Design and make a flag for your own pirate ship.
