Daily / Weekly

- **Reading:** please continue to read with your child every day and ask them questions to check they understand what they are reading.
- **Mathletics:** weekly tasks will be set to support the learning we are doing in class.
- **Spellings:** This term we will continue to learn statutory spellings for years 3 and 4, and practise words that are commonly misspelled by our classes. Like last term, we have created spelling booklets which should be kept at home. Each sheet is dated and the date of the test is indicated. Those with the differentiated version will also have individual spellings each week which they will be tested on on the Friday.
